The Enterprise Development funding provided has resulted in a Service Level Agreement between Awaneo and ROWSA.

PROGRAMME

ROWSA has a long list of infrastructure and equipment needs.

Awaneo has been able to address the following priorities at ROWSA's primary training facility:

- *New Jetties*
- *New Jetty embankments*
- *Rehabilitation of the foreshore environment*

The jetties used are now up to date with modern requirements, having first been installed in the 1970's.

SCENARIO

In support of South Africa's Paralympic bid, Awaneo, as a qualifying Enterprise Development beneficiary, identified the need to address the escalating medical expenses falling on SASCOG.

PROGRAMME

CLIENT

Awaneo was approached by a corporate client to assist in developing and managing a tangible, sports-focused Socio-Economic Development solution for the 2021 Financial Year.

In partnership with key stakeholders, the rehabilitation of existing sporting infrastructure and implementation of a new 5-a-side soccer pitch to serve the Orlando East community in Soweto was agreed on as the SED project.

PROGRAMME

Stadium Management South Africa (SMSA) and their main stakeholder, the City of Johannesburg, identified an existing facility (FIFA World Cup 2010 Legacy project) which requires some serious TLC.

The facilities will also be used as a job-creation opportunity, serving the local community.

IMPACT & OUTCOMES

A secondary and primary school, as well as local sporting organisations will all benefit from the upgrade.

Sports available to the community will be *Basketball, Netball and Soccer*

Local resources will be used in the building process.

Micro-enterprise opportunities exist for suppliers to benefit by delivering services to sustain the facility.

Use of the facility, SMSA's stadia and events, will be used to deliver practical training to Learners (Skills Dev), ultimately to develop competent resources and entrepreneurs.
